

Regulations for using the garden located on the rooftop of the building of the Copernicus Science Centre at 20 Wybrzeże Kościuszkowskie St. in Warszawa

1. The garden located on the rooftop of the building of the Copernicus Science Centre (hereinafter the „Garden”):

- 1) is available for visitors from 1 May to 31 October.
- 2) is closed between 1 November and 30 April.

2. The Copernicus Science Centre reserves the right to change the above-mentioned dates. Detailed informations about opening dates and hours are listed on the website www.kopernik.org.pl and at the Garden's entrance.

3. All persons staying in the Garden are obliged to comply with the provisions of these regulations and follow the instructions of the employees of the Copernicus Science Centre and the security guards.

4. In justifiable circumstances, Copernicus Science Centre has the right to temporarily change the rules of the Garden's availability and implement additional rules for visitors. Information about any introduced changes will be communicated on the website www.kopernik.org.pl and at the Garden's entrance.

5. Entry to the Garden is possible only via the southern ramp (from the direction of Świętokrzyski Bridge), while exit takes place via the northern ramp (from the direction of the University of Warsaw Library).

6. Admission to the Garden is free of charge.

7. Entering the Garden is not possible during storms and strong wind.

8. A specified number of persons can be present in the Garden, and exceeding of this number means that all following persons will have to wait for their turn to enter.

9. In the Garden, it is only allowed to move along the designated pedestrian lanes. In particular, it is prohibited to bike, skate, skateboard, etc.

10. The persons staying in the Garden are forbidden to:

- 1) bring animals (except guide dogs),
- 2) destroy plants and garden furniture,
- 3) lean out through the railings,
- 4) climb the walls (railings) and flower beds,
- 5) throw any objects from the rooftop,
- 6) drink alcohol,
- 7) use psychoactive substances,
- 8) smoke (the prohibition includes electronic cigarettes),
- 9) conduct business or advertising.

11. Persons under the influence of alcohol are not allowed in the Garden.

12. Persons under the influence of psychoactive substances are not allowed in the Garden.

13. Children can visit the Garden only under the supervision of adults.

14. It is necessary to obtain the consent of the Copernicus Science Centre in order to:

- 1) organise an event or meeting in the Garden,
- 2) conduct scientific observations or research in the Garden,
- 3) stay in the Garden outside the hours indicated on the website www.kopernik.org.pl and at the Garden's entrance.

15. In order to obtain the consent to carry out the activities specified in point 14 in the Garden, it is necessary to contact the Copernicus Science Centre by writing to the electronic mail address at: info@kopernik.org.pl.

16. The Copernicus Science Centre shall not be responsible for any damages suffered by persons staying in the Garden resulting from non-compliance with the generally applicable law and the provisions of these regulations, as well as for the property brought or left in the Garden.

17. The Copernicus Science Centre reserves the right to remove from the Garden any persons not complying with the provisions of the regulations or not following the instructions of the Centre's employees or security guards.
